## PURPOSE:

To ensure the rights of patient visitation.

## POLICY:

Madison County Memorial Hospital complies with Florida's No Patient Left Alone Act by posting its patient visitation policy on the hospital's website at <a href="mcmh.us">mcmh.us</a> and may request visitors to agree in writing to follow the hospital's visitation policies and procedures.

## In-Person Visitation

In-person visitation is allowed in all the following circumstances, unless the patient objects:

- At the request of the patient.
- · End-of-life situations.
- Patient who was living with family before admission and is struggling with the change in environment and lack of in-person family support.
- · Patient making one or more major medical decisions.
- Patient experiencing emotional distress or grieving a recent death.
- Patient needs cueing or encouragement to eat or drink which was previously
  provided by a family member or caregiver.
- Patient who used to talk and interact with others is now seldom speaking.
- Childbirth, including labor and delivery.
- Pediatric patients.

## Essential Caregiver

 A patient may designate an essential caregiver (family member, friend, guardian, or other individual).
